What Matty uncovers prompts shame and denial, setting the village against itself, and threatening all those who live there.

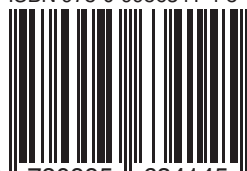


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
